



NOTICE OF VOTE TLA'AMIN (SLIAMMON) NATION CONSTITUTION

TO: SLIAMMON INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE

TAKE NOTICE that a Tla'amin Nation Constitution Vote will be held in accordance with the Sliammon Ratification Committee Rules of Procedure to determine if Eligible Voters approve the Tla'amin Nation Constitution. Copies of the Sliammon Ratification Committee Rules of Procedure are available at the Sliammon Treaty Office, the Sliammon Band Office or on the Sliammon Treaty Society website at www.sliammontreaty.com.

The following question will be asked:

Ballot Question: Do you approve the Tla'amin Nation Constitution dated July 13, 2009?

HOW CAN YOU VOTE?

Each person whose name appears on the Official Voters List for the Tla'amin Nation Constitution Vote will receive a mail-in ballot voting package. If you have not received a mail-in ballot and believe you are eligible to vote you may request a mail-in ballot voting package by contacting us **Toll Free at 1-877-483-8683 (1-877-483-VOTE)** or via e-mail at SliammonRC@gmail.com.

If you choose to **VOTE BY MAIL** you must use the prepaid self-addressed envelope to return your mail-in ballot and the envelope must be received by the Chief Electoral Officer no later than **8:00 p.m. on October 24, 2009**, in order to be counted.

However, your mail-in ballot may be delivered to the Voting Place no later than **8:00 p.m. on OCTOBER 24, 2009**.

Even though you have received a mail-in ballot package, you may vote in person.

If you choose to **VOTE IN PERSON** the Vote will take place on **October 22 and 24**, between **10:00 am and 8:00 pm**, at the following locations:

- a) **October 22 Vancouver Aboriginal Friendship Centre,
Chief Simon Baker Room, 1607 E. Hastings St. Vancouver, BC**
- b) **October 24 Sliammon Salish Centre, 4885 Salish Drive, Powell River, BC**

****PLEASE BRING YOUR MAIL-IN BALLOT WITH YOU WHEN YOU COME TO VOTE.**

INDIVIDUALS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE: An individual is eligible to vote if that individual:

- (a) has been placed on the Official Voters List for Sliammon and is 18 years of age or older on or before October 24, 2009; or
- (b) provides a Voting Officer or the Chief Electoral Officer with
 - i. a completed application for enrolment; or
 - ii. evidence satisfactory to a Voting Officer or Chief Electoral Officer that the individual has submitted a completed enrolment application form to the Enrolment Committee; and
 - iii. provides evidence satisfactory to a Voting Officer or Chief Electoral Officer that the individual will be at least 18 years of age on or before October 24, 2009.

VOTER IDENTIFICATION: One or two pieces of identification containing, in combination, the voter's name, signature, and address are required to be shown at the polls.
